

CYPHERS

Caesar Cipher
Jefferson Wheel



The code was named after Julius Caesar, Emperor of Rome from 46-44 BC.

This type of substitution protected his military communications.

Decode the Museum

CAESAR CIPHER

SECURE COMMUNICATION is vital during dangerous times! ENCODE messages so the enemy cannot read messages.

Method to Encrypt or Decrypt

- > Create 2 alphabet wheel.
- Determine rule, known as the SHIFT KEY, to encode the message by rotating the outer wheel.
- > Repeat for each letter in the message.

Caesar cipher is also known as Shift Cipher. This shifting property can be hidden in the name of Caesar variants: CD code, C = D, the shift is 1 Jail (JL) code, J = L, the shift is 2 Ellen (LN) code, L = N, the shift is 2 Cutie (QT) code, Q = T, the shift is 3 Eiffel (FL) code, F = L, the shift is 6 WC code, W = C, the shift is 6 Empty (MT) code, M = T, the shift is 7 Baden Powell (Boy Scout founder), B = P, the shift is 14 Any (NE) code, N = E, the shift is 17 See You (CU) code, C = U, the shift is 18 I See (IC) code, I = C, the shift is 20 Easy (EZ) code, E = Z, the shift is 21

Invented in 1789 by Thomas Jefferson during the American Revolution.

JEFFERSON WHEEL

SECURE COMMUNICATION!

ENCODE messages so the enemy cannot open mail and read correspondence.

Method to Encrypt or Decrypt

- > Select unique disc set that have letters or symbols on disc edge.
- > Stack wheels on an axle and turn wheels to form message.
- > Secure all wheels to turn at the same time.
- Message on one line and all others serve as a potential encryption codes.
